महोदय,

निदेशानुसार उपर्युक्त विषय के सम्बन्ध में कहना है कि राज्य सरकार के अधीन लिखित परीक्षा या लिखित परीक्षा के बाद साक्षात्कार या मात्र साक्षात्कार के भाष्यम से की जाने वाली सीधी भर्ती द्वारा नियुक्ति के मामले में आरक्षित वर्ग यथा— अनुसूचित जाति/अनुसूचित जनजाति/ अत्यन्त पिछड़ा वर्ग (अनुसूची-1)/पिछड़ा वर्ग (अनुसूची-2) के वैसे अभ्यर्थियों जिनका घयन उपनी मेधा के आधार पर होता है उन्हें अनारक्षित रिक्तियों के विरुद्ध सामजित माना जाय था नहीं यह मामला राज्य सरकार के विचाराधीन था।

कार्मिक, लोक शिकायत तथा पेशन मंत्रालय, भारत सरकार के कार्यालय ज्ञापन संख्या—36012/22/93-ईस्ट(एस.सी.टी.) दिनांक 08.09.1993 तथा 36011/1/98 ईस्ट (रेज) दिनांक 01.07.1998 से राज्य सरकार को यह समाधान हो गया है कि आरक्षित वर्ग के वैसे अभ्यर्थी जिनका घयन उन मानकों के आधार पर होता है जो सामान्य अभ्यर्थियों के लिए विहित हो उन्हें आरक्षित वर्ग के रिक्तियों के विरुद्ध सामजित नहीं किया जायेगा। दूसरे शब्दों में जब आरक्षित वर्ग के अभ्यर्थियों का घयन सामान्य वर्ग के अभ्यर्थियों की तुलना में उपरी उम्र सीमा, अनुभव, शैक्षणिक योग्यता, लिखित परीक्षा में बैठने के अवसरों की संख्या में छूट/रियायत प्रदान कर की जाती है एवं विस्तारित विचारण

क्षेत्र के आधार पर होता है तो वे सम्बन्धित आरक्षित वर्ग के रिक्तियों के विलम्ब सामंजित होंगे। ऐसे अभ्यर्थी अनारक्षित रिक्तियों के लिए अनुपलब्ध समझे जायेंगे।

यह तत्काल प्रभाव से लागू होगा।



OFFICE MEMORANDUM

Subject: Relaxations and concessions for SCs and STs - Clarification regarding.

The undersigned is directed to refer to this Departmental O.M. No.36011/1/98-Estt.(SCR) dated May 22, 1998 and to clarify that the instructions contained in the O.M. apply in all types of direct recruitment whether by written test alone or written test followed by interview.

2. O.M. dated May 22, 1998 referred to above and the O.M. No.36011/2/98-STT(RES) dated July 2, 1997 provide that in cases of direct recruitment, the SC/ST/CSC candidates who are selected on their own merit will not be adjusted against reserved vacancies.

3. In this connection, it is clarified that only SC/ST/CSC candidates who are selected on the same standard as applied to general candidates shall not be adjusted against reserved vacancies. In other words, while a uniform standard is adopted in selecting all SC/ST/CSC candidates, for example in case of IIT, IIM, experience qualification, etc., the same may be relaxed in case of SC/ST/CSC candidates. Thus, if the standard of selection for SC/ST/CSC candidates is larger than what is provided for general candidates then the SC/ST/CSC candidates will be qualified based on reserved vacancies. If the standard is smaller, then the SC/ST/CSC candidates will be deemed as unqualified for reserved vacancies.

The undersigned is directed to note, as the Government of India has instructed, that
as per the 1st August, 1993, and the Department, 1993, regarding instructions for
Ministerial Assistance Scheme in Civil Posts and Services under the Government of India and
the following the Government's latest instructions to the various Commissions of India and other relevant bodies to be followed in
order to accommodate the various categories of posts in view of the Government of India's instruction in respect of the conduct of examinations of candidates appointed on the basis
of merit in accordance with the Government's scheme to meet posts not covered under the Government of India.

2. **Compliance to the instructions of the Exams Committee's recommendations** that the Government
will not discriminate the merit of the various posts, which will be reflected in the merit list, when it
is being considered to provide of posts:

- (a) The Government's intent of the selection of new posts and services under the
Government of India to be done through direct recruitment and as directed by the Exams
Committee's recommendations relating to the procedure to be followed by
various authorities following in this regard as the basis of merit in an open competition to
serve satisfactorily personnel for the general administration and not be restricted against the
Schedule in this regard.
 - (b) The rule of recruitment and new posts in various categories as defined in Ministry
of Welfare.
 - (c) The rules for the purpose of the selection committee's recommendations, as the case may
be, which are concerned with the basis for the basis of the merit of the
various posts determined by the Ministry of Welfare.
3. **Sharing information in respect of public sector undertakings and financial institutions** and
other bodies will be known by the Government of India, which will be the subject of
information sharing from the date of the letter mentioned and by the Ministry of
